

Master of Science in International Business (MIB) 2024-2025

Admission requirements:

All applicants for the Master of Science in International Business have to go through an admission procedure.

The minimal requirements to qualify for admission is a Bachelor degree:

The program will last 2 years (**24-month track**) including 1 semester being devoted to the Master thesis.

Exception is provided to applicants holding a validated Master degree or an equivalent 4 year Bachelor degree (240 ECTS credits). The ELIGIBLE students will attend 2 semesters of courses followed by a Master thesis (**18-month track**)

Students who are expecting to graduate soon or waiting for results when applying, can be admitted as well. Their admission will then be subject to their graduation.

■ Advanced level of English

- ◇ The following test scores will be sufficient to accept the applicant: TOEFL 550, TOEIC 750, IELTS 6.0.
- ◇ Native English speakers.
- ◇ Applicants holding a degree that is fully taught in English are exempted from this requirement

Admission procedures :

- First step: online application: <https://talentdays.brest-bs.com/>
- Second step: students who qualify will be called for an online interview.

Financial information:

Fees are 13900€ for 18-month track or 17500€ for 24-month track (additionally, 100 € will have to be paid towards Logistics and Administrative Services fees).

- There is a limited number of scholarships are available for the 2024-2025 academic year. Students may apply after being admitted at BBS.

The application file should contain:

- Online application form duly completed
- Certified copy of diploma(s)
- Certified copy of transcript or academic records (mentioning courses, credits, marks)
- Proof of professional experience (if relevant)
- Letter of motivation
- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Proof of language test (if relevant)
- 2 reference letters (from professors and/or professionals)
- Copy of passport or ID card
- 1 passport-sized photograph

Certified translation of documents should be provided for documents that are neither in English or French. Scanned copies are accepted.
